



Best Practice 2

Title of the Practice: Empowering HER to empower the NATION

Objective: Sammilani Mahavidyalaya has taken initiatives for women's empowerment and various activities are organised throughout the year to empower the girl students most of whom comes from remote area. The College tries to Provide skill development, career counselling, and leadership training to empower girl students for their economic independence. It also ensures safety &well-being by implementing anti-harassment policies, grievance redressal mechanisms, and support systems to safeguard women's rights in alignment with the vision of this institution.

The Context: In the prevalent patriarchal society both the Central and State Govt. have undertaken various welfare projects for the overall development and upliftment of the women in the society. In the context of those efforts taken by the govt. our college has been implementing several programs for empowering the girl students.

The Practice:

Practice related to women - empowerment that took place during the session are:

- 1. Celebration of International Women's Day
- 2. Basic Tailoring Course for girl students.
- 3. Internship in Fashion designing for girl students.
- 4. Kanyashree Prakalpa.
- 5. Representation in IQAC by girl student.

Evidence of Success

1. International Women's Day was celebrated on 21st March 2024. A lecture was organized by Women Cell and IQAC of the institution where an eminent guest speaker: Dr. Samiran Sur, Assistant Professor, Department of Management and Business Administration, Aliah University, was invited to deliver lecture on the topic "Invest in Her Future: Women's Entrepreneurial Journey" at Vidyasagar Hall. Students prepared a wall magazine on the topic "contribution of the first lady eminent in different fields of work", which was unveiled in the program.





2. Tailoring course: A diploma course in Basic Tailoring for the girl student offers the scope of self employment as well as an 'earn while you learn' opportunity. 20 to25 girl students even from other colleges and local area are learning the course.

3. Internship: The HEI has offered an internship course as stipulated by the affiliating University on Fashion designing only for girls. It helped them to develop a new skill that could be beneficial in near future.

4. Kanyasree Prakalpa: On an average about 70% of the total girl students received Kanyashree every year. In this session 85 girl students have received the scholarship.

5. There is a student representative in the IQAC who is a girl student. The College took this initiative to encourage participation and leadership in governance .

Problems Encountered and Resource Required:

- Many women, especially from economically weaker backgrounds, struggle to afford higher education due to financial dependence on families.
- Motivation among girl students are required regarding taking other courses along with their studies.
- Introduction of CBCS and New CCF syllabus required continuous 10 to 4 class thus many students found it difficult to find time during the class hours hence could not join the courses.
- The students find it inconvenient to come to college for the courses every day.
- Since it is a general degree college, there is no dedicated teacher for the courses. More fund is required.
- Women often face challenges in balancing education with household responsibilities, limiting their academic and extracurricular participation.
- Traditional mindsets and cultural expectations often restrict women's participation in higher education and leadership roles.
